Participants will learn about the "credit crunch," how to obtain and use credit (even with a low credit score), read a credit report roadmap, how to report errors on a credit report, ways to build or demonstrate credit history, the cost and reward of credit, what other agencies are using credit to judge payment character, and more! This is the first workshop in a three-part series; follow-up workshops include balancing a household budget and using debt-elimination strategies for success.
